SISTER HERBERT O'BRIEN

Sister Herbert O'Brien, missioned since 1956 at the Nativity Convent, St. Paul, died Monday, June 10 in the chapel at the College of St. Catherine, while making her annual retreat. Born in Prince Edward Island, Canada on October 10, 1888, Sister was the daughter of Michael H. O'Brien and Johanna Donohue.

Having received the habit at St. Joseph's Novitiate on March 19, 1912, Sister Herbert made her profession two years later. For the forty-six years of her religious life, she was engaged in food service at our convents in Waverly, Kilkenny, Fulda, Ghent, Graceville; and in St. Paul, at St. Joseph's Academy, St. Michael's Convent and St. Agatha's Conservatory.

In addition to her sisters, Sister Zoe, who lives at Bethany, St. Paul, and Sister Camillus of St. Teresa's Convent in Hastings, Sister is survived by two brothers, Herbert and Alfred, and by three other sisters, Mrs. John Christopher, Mrs. Herman Cahill, and Mrs. Peter Gavin, all of Prince Edward Island.

Following the Requiem High Mass celebrated by The Right Reverend Monsignor James M. Reardon in the Chapel of the Presentation at St. Joseph's Provincial House, on Wednesday, June 12, Sister Herbert was buried in Resurrection Cemetery.
