Sister M. Gerald Corcoran died at St. Mary's Hospital, Minneapolis, Minn., on the thirteenth day of May, nineteen hundred twelve, in the twenty-eighth year of her age and the eleventh of her religious life.

Not many in number, but rich in merit, no doubt, before God, were the years spent in religion by our dear Sister Gerald. Gentle, unassuming and self-sacrificing, she continued her work in the school room until within a few weeks of her death.

Not because of her failing strength, but only through obedience, did she consent to the much-needed rest that in so short a time proved final.

This dear Sister's memory will be long cherished by her companions for her many acts of charity and loving kindness.

May our dear Lord grant her the reward promised to those who leave all to labor for Him alone!

**Death of Sister Gerald:** Sister Gerald Corcoran died at St. Mary's Hospital, Minneapolis, last Monday, after a brief illness of less than two weeks' duration. The funeral services were held in the chapel of the hospital on Wednesday morning, May 15, the Mass of Requiem being celebrated by the Rev. James M. Reardon, who also gave the final absolution. The remains were interred in St. Mary's cemetery, Minneapolis.

The deceased Sister was born at Baldwin's Road, Prince Edward Island, Canada, on April 15, 1885. She came to St. Paul in 1900 and joined the Sisters of St. Joseph at St. Joseph's Academy. After her profession she taught in different schools conducted by the Order, in North Dakota and Minnesota, and during the past year was located at Fulda, Minn.
